



THE BATELEURS

The Bateleurs are a Blues/Rock band based in Lisbon, Portugal; their debut Video EP “The Immanent Fire” was released digitally in October 2018. Strongly influenced by the great icons of the British and American rock with blues roots from the early seventies, with a modern and regional twist that adds flavor to a style always ripe for new approaches. After a run of shows in their country in 2019, they started collaborating with the LeStrato Rock booking agency, and been touring Spain regularly. Their debut LP “The Sun in the Tenth House” was released by Spanish label MilanaMúsica in May 2022. The record was mastered at Infrasonic Sound, Nashville TN (Rival Sons, Chris Stapleton) by the acclaimed engineer David Gardner. With shows already booked in Portugal and Spain, a full European tour is in the works, and the production of the upcoming new album is rapidly coming together.
